White

	Glass (6 oz.)	Bottle
Pinot Gris 2008 Willm	8.50	32
The same grape as pinot grigio but in the Alsatian style. Buttery and crisp, with a floral bouquet and lots of fruit.		
Viognier 2008 Les Salices	8.50	32
A viognier from the Pays d'Oc. Dry but with plenty of viognier fruit - a delicious alternative to chardonnay.		
Chateau Montaud 2009 Cotes de Provence Rose	7.50	28
A wine with the sunny disposition of the south of France. Estate bottled.		
Sparkling Blanquette de Limoux Brut 2007 St. Hilaire		30
France's first sparkling wine, even before Champagne. Dry, but with a hint of sweetness similar to a Moet White Star.		
Picpoul de Pinet 2008 La Chapelle de la Bastide		28
Picpoul de Pinet is the oldest indigenous grape varietal of the Languedoc. A tart and delicious alternative to chardonnay.		
Macon-Ige 2007 Princess Anne		28
A dry, crisp chardonnay from the Maconnais region of France.		
Graves de Vayres 2008 Chateau Fage		28
A classic white bordeaux blend of sauvignon blanc and semillon. Dry, fresh, clean and a great price.		
Chimney Creek 2008 Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand		28
Dry and crisp with the classic citrus New Zealand sauvignon blanc finish.		
Gruener Veltliner 2008 Aichenberg		26
The newly popular white wine from Austria.		

Red

Anjou Rouge Logis de La Giraudiere 2005 Domaine Baumard	9.00	34
A cabernet franc from the Loire Valley. A light, dry wine with mature fruit and a touch of leather in the finish.		
Cotes-du-Rhone 2009 Domaine Pere Caboché		28
A Cotes-du-Rhone from Chateauneuf du Pape estates and made by the mayor of Chateauneuf du Pape, Jean-Pierre Boisson.		
Cahors 2004 Chateau La Tour Chambert		30
The classic rich wine from the Southwest of France. Organically grown and aged in oak barrels, an elegant blend of malbec, merlot and tannat with a strong bouquet of red fruits.		
MacMurray Ranch Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir 2008		36
A pinot noir in the French style from the estate of late actor Fred MacMurray. Light, refreshingly tart with lots of bright red fruit.		
Ramsay 2006 North Coast Cabernet Sauvignon		32
An excellent California cabernet: fruit forward but restrained with gentle tannins.		
Castle Rock 2006 Napa Valley Merlot		29
A California style merlot with deep ruby color and velvety textures. Hints of blackberry, oak and cedar with a long, smooth finish.		
The Flying Winemaker Lodi Zinfandel 2007		28
A delicious zinfandel made from ancient Lodi vines by the well known winemaker Cameron Hughes.		
Diablo de Uco 2004 Malbec		27
From the Uco Valley, estate grown and bottled in Mendoza, Argentina. An intense malbec that opens in the glass with lots of blackberry flavors.		
McWilliams Hanwood Estate Australian Shiraz 2007		25
A shiraz (Australian for syrah) from one of the oldest wineries in Australia.		

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
