Pinot Gris 2010 Willm	8.50	32
The same grape as pinot grigio but in the Alsatian style. Buttery and crisp, with a floral bouquet and lots of fruit.		
Viognier 2009 Les Salices	8.50	32
A viognier from the Pays d'Oc. Dry but with plenty of viognier fruit - a delicious alternative to chardonnay.		
Rose Domaine du Pere Caboché 2010	7.50	28
Vin de Pays de Vaucluse		
Picpoul de Pinet 2009 La Chapelle de la Bastide		28
Picpoul de Pinet is the oldest indigenous grape varietal of the Languedoc. A tart and delicious alternative to chardonnay.		
Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie 2007 Comte Leloup du Chateau de Chasseloir		32
A rich, ripe and silken wine from ungrafter 100 year old Melon de Bourgogne vines.		
Graves de Vayres 2010 Chateau Fage		28
A classic white bordeaux blend of sauvignon blanc and semillon. Dry, fresh, clean and a great price.		
The Flying Winemaker Santa Barbara County Chardonnay 2008		28
A delicious, lightly oaked Chardonnay from the micro-climate of Santa Barbara County, California.		
Chimney Creek 2010 Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand		28
Dry and crisp with the classic citrus New Zealand sauvignon blanc finish.		
Gruner Veltliner 2008 Aichenberg		26
The newly popular white wine from Austria.		

Red

Chateau de Castelneau 2007 Bordeaux Merlot		28
An all merlot Bordeaux wine from 90 year old vines.		
Red Rock Merlot 2009 Modesto California		28
A lush and smooth merlot with concentrations of black plum and boysenberry.		
Cotes-du-Rhone 2010 Domaine Pere Caboché		28
A Cotes-du-Rhone from Chateauneuf du Pape estates and made by the mayor of Chateauneuf du Pape, Jean-Pierre Boisson.		
Cahors 2004 Chateau La Tour Chambert		30
The classic rich wine from the Southwest of France. Organically grown and aged in oak barrels, an elegant blend of malbec, merlot and tannat with a strong bouquet of red fruits.		
MacMurray Ranch Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir 2008		38
A pinot noir in the French style from the estate of late actor Fred MacMurray. Light, refreshingly tart with lots of bright red fruit.		
Ramsay 2007 North Coast Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon		32
An excellent California cabernet: fruit forward but restrained with gentle tannins.		
Aguaribay 2009 Malbec Mendoza, Argentina		28
Produced by Baron Edmond de Rothschild.		
McWilliams Hanwood Estate Australian Shiraz 2008		25
A shiraz (Australian for syrah) from one of the oldest wineries in Australia.
